Dearest Friends, Singers, Parents and Supporters of VOS,

I hope this letter finds you well. I write to you to provide some updates on Voices of Singapore and our call to action with the Covid-19 situation.

The Covid-19 outbreak that has affected the world has been one of the biggest challenges for many in 2020. It is in these times that we find ourselves banding together to help one another, and I am both moved and deeply grateful that everyone at Voices of Singapore - from our staff to our conductors, educators, facilitators, singers and parents, have offered help in one way or another.

Our mission and vision of using music to inspire have never been stronger. We are using music not just to educate, but to unite, inspire and heal.

We are working hard to ensure the safety of all our singers and staff. VOS has now increased sanitisation processes that include disinfecting the space after every class or rehearsal. For the Children's Choir, we have conducted extra briefings to our conductors and facilitators to ensure stringent temperature checks and safer distances between participants.

VOS has also been greatly involved in assisting the Arts Scene, having hosted the nation-wide Town-hall meeting for Arts Instructors in Singapore, which was jointly organized by NTUC and National Instructors and Coaches Association.

We also took steps to postpone our largest event of the year, the Voices of Singapore Festival, which was supposed to happen this March. These steps were taken even before government regulations were put in place. It was a difficult but necessary step to ensure the safety of our 10,000 participants. It is tentatively postponed to September, pending regulatory updates. We also had to cancel our VOS Community Chorus recital to ensure the safety of the large ensemble and our audience.

With the recent regulations for gatherings exceeding 250 persons to be cancelled, our children's choir presentation concert at Capitol Theatre this May is temporarily put on hold, pending more updates.

For parents of VOS Children's Choir, rehearsals and classes will continue to function as per normal until further notice, with the extra precautions taken. Our conductors, staff

and myself, are dedicated to ensure the continual and holistic growth of your child. Our motivation is seeing our young singers grow from strength to strength each term, and it truly is a testament to the hard work and dedication of the VOS teaching and administrative team.
